POWER IN THE MIRACLES JOHN 2:1-11

We are not to get too taken up with the miracles Jesus performed other than to admire His glory as al powerful God.

Mary's instruction to the servants was, "Whatsoever he saith unto you, do it." Obedience for the servants meant shifting up to 120 gallons of water!

Fig tree cursed	Mark 11:12-14	Vegetable life
Demoniac cured	Matthew 8:28-34	Satanic realm
Lazarus	John 11:1-44	Death
